Position Specific

- 1. Ability to lead students in authentic, excellent, and meaningful worship vocally and from a guitar or keyboard.
- 2. Ability to recruit, motivate, equip, and deploy qualified middle school, high school and/or adult worship team and audio/visual support volunteers
- 3. Ability to have a cooperative, healthy, and motivating relationship with ministry staff, students, parents, and adult volunteers
- 4. Ability to use appropriate judgment with discretion, sensitivity, and confidentiality
- 5. Self-starter, reliable team player who will embrace and adapt to growth, change, innovation, and creativity
- 6. Willingness to learn or grow their aptitude for ProPresenter, Planning Center, music production and multi-track software and basic audio/visual production.

RESPONSIBILITIES

(Estimate of Hours per Week Devoted to Each in Parenthesis)

Corporate Worship Leading (70%)

- 1. Plan and lead meaningful corporate worship at weekly high school and middle school gatherings on Wednesday nights and occasional student ministries events, trips and retreats, including but not limited to:
 - a. Choosing songs and arrangements and preparing rehearsal materials
 - b. Planning scripture, prayer and transitionary elements of corporate worship
 - c. Organizing, scheduling and communicating with worship team and audio/visual support volunteers
 - d. Preparing song lyric service graphics to be displayed during gatherings
 - e. Setting up and overseeing the use of the audio/visual equipment
 - f. Conducting worship team rehearsals prior to each gathering
 - g. Leading the worship team volunteers and student body in corporate worship through singing and/or playing an instrument during the gatherings
 - h. Shutting down the A/V equipment and cleaning up the platform after the gatherings
- 2. Collaborate with the student ministries staff to give ideas for relevant creative elements during corporate worship at weekly programming and occasional events, retreats and trips.
- 3. Occasionally Work with Worship Arts Administrative Assistant on copyright compliance.

Team Building and Leadership Development (30%)

- 1. Recruit, train, and mentor/coach worship team and audio/visual support volunteers.
- 2. Preform subsequent, ongoing evaluation of worship team and audio/visual support volunteers.
- 3. Meet regularly with the student ministries staff for ministry planning purposes.
- 4. Commit to grow in ministry competency in areas of musical skill, worship theology and ministry leadership through regular coaching and practice.
- 5. Preform other functions and task upon availability as requested by the student ministries staff.

RELATIONSHIPS

- 1. This position reports to the Pastor of Student Ministries.
- 2. This position supports the Pastor/Director of Middle/High School Ministries.
- 3. This position interfaces with the Worship Arts Ministries to:
 - a. Receive direction for corporate worship values, song selection, and resourcing from the Worship Arts Pastor
 - b. Receive support and coaching from the Worship Arts Associate
 - c. Receive audio/visual training and resourcing from the Technical Arts Associate and Video Producer.
- 4. This position works closely with all staff members, lay leaders, students, and parents.
